


Microsoft Outlook 2003 has a feature that lets you recover your **deleted** items after you've emptied your **deleted** Items folder. If you **click** on the Tools menu, you'll see a Recover Deleted Items option. You will find though, that the option is often greyed out. This can be a real pain if you've just mistakenly Deleted an item. Here's how to enable the option:

- Close Microsoft Outlook 2003
- Press **Windows key + R** (This will bring up the Run dialog)
- In the . dialog box type **regedit** and press **Enter**
- Navigate to:
HKEY_LOCAL_MACHINE\Software\Microsoft\Exchange\Client\Options
- On the right hand **window** pane you will see a few string values. Ignore them. Right-**click** anywhere in the white space and **select New->DWORD Value**
- Type in **DumpsterAlwaysOn** as the DWORD's name. Now double-click on DumpsterAlwaysOn and change the **value** to **1**. [See pic below]



You can now close the Registry Editor window.

- Open Microsoft Outlook 2003. Click **Tools->Recover Deleted Items**

- You should see a list of items you recently deleted. **Select** what you want restored and click the **Recover Selected Items** button. [See pic below]



The items will then appear in your Deleted Items folder.
